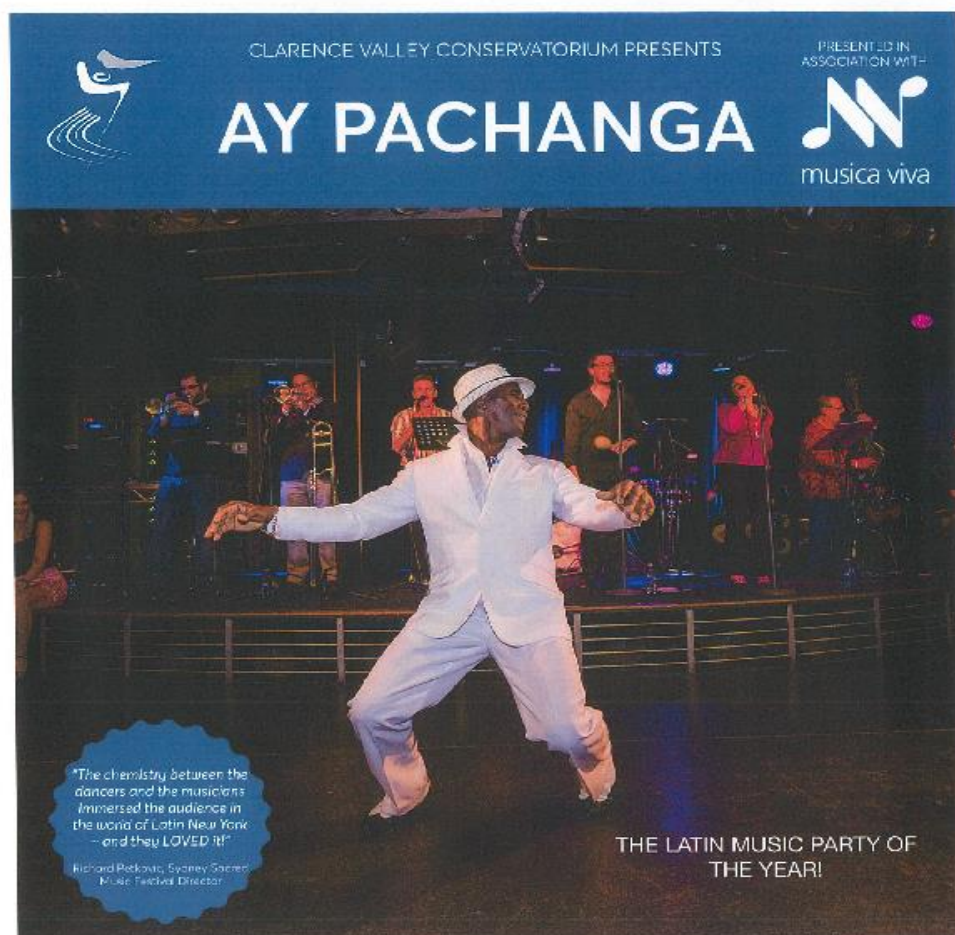
Coutts Crossing Tennis Club Fun Day
